**CORY JACKSON** (FBC missionary) - The doctor explained that with metastatic melanoma that is found in the brain, it is typically considered stage four. Even with the unique occurrence of discovering no other areas of concern on Cory's scans, there is a 90% chance with this type and stage of cancer of it recurring in the future. The doctor highly recommended a year-long course of immunotherapy (different from chemotherapy) that can greatly reduce the chances of the cancer returning. Many people experience auto-immune responses to immunotherapy. When that happens, Cory's treatment will pause while he goes on a steroid to reduce inflammation in the body before proceeding with further treatment. That may also extend the timeline of the treatment, depending on how Cory's body responds. With the comparatively minimal negative side effects, they are opting to move forward with this recommended treatment plan. Cory and Brooke would appreciate your prayers for wisdom as they process the new developments and how this affects their plans and decision making for future ministry overseas.

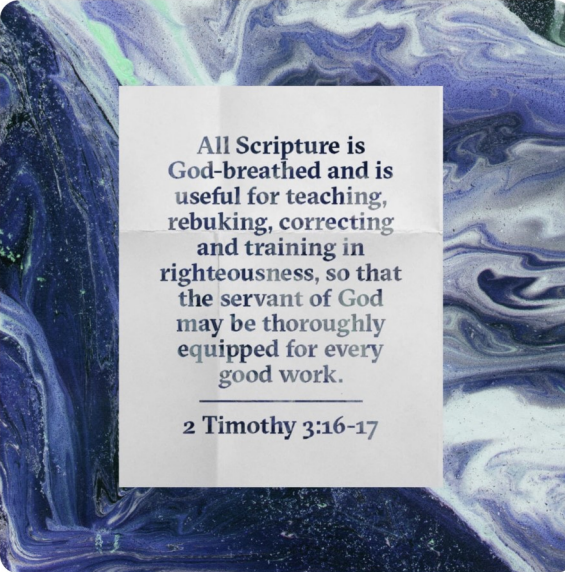
