JACOBO REYES (Enrique's Dad) made it to Texas but had a fainting spell that will now also have to be checked into.

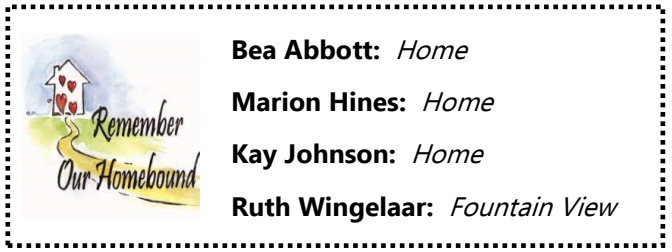
