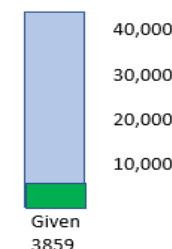
Tim Bont is leading the Family Life Class in a Bible study/discussion on the book of James. The class meets in the lower level of the educational building.
